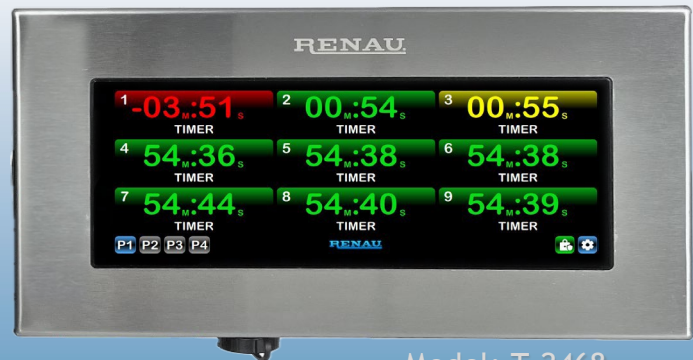

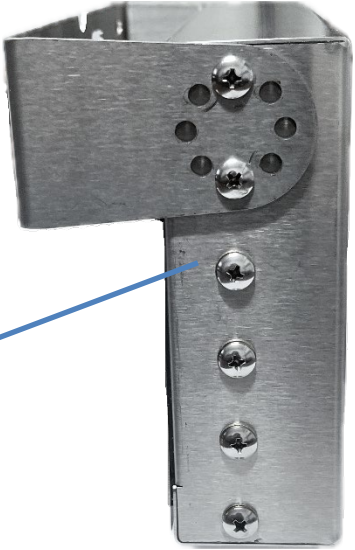

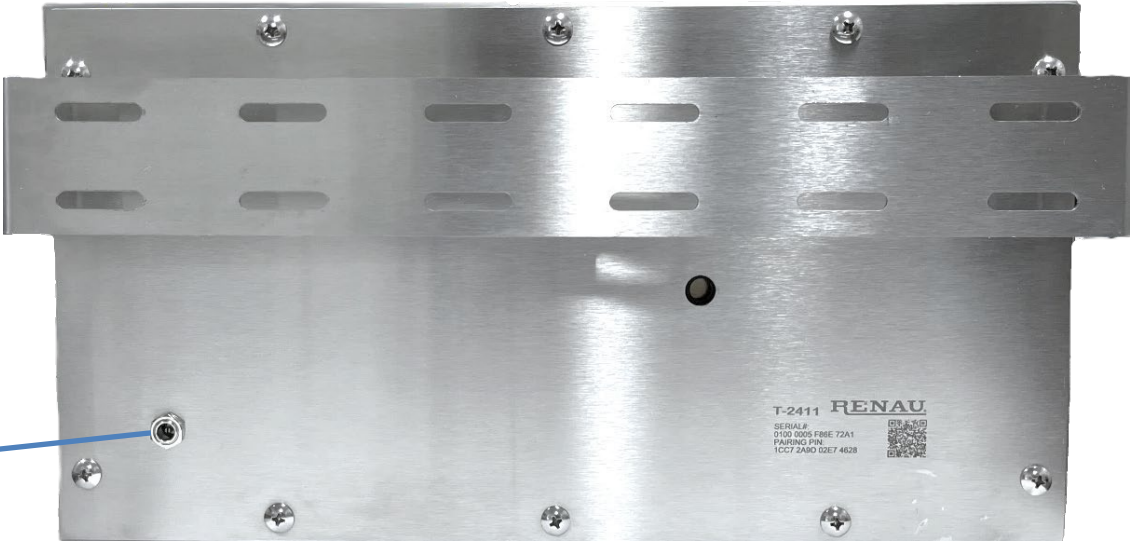

Programming Screen Layout

1. Connect the unit to a power source. Once powered **ON**, the Renau logo will appear on the display, accompanied by an audible buzzer, indicating that the timer is **ON**.



Note: Make sure power supply is inserted completely.

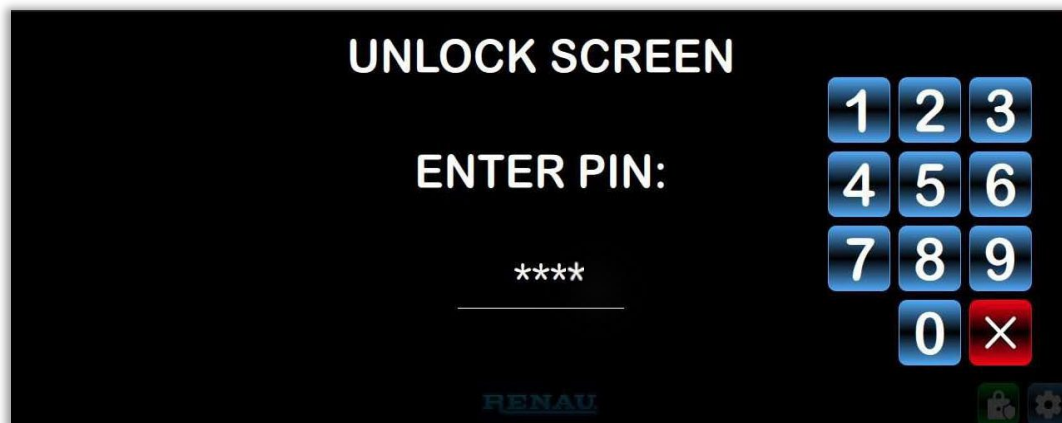


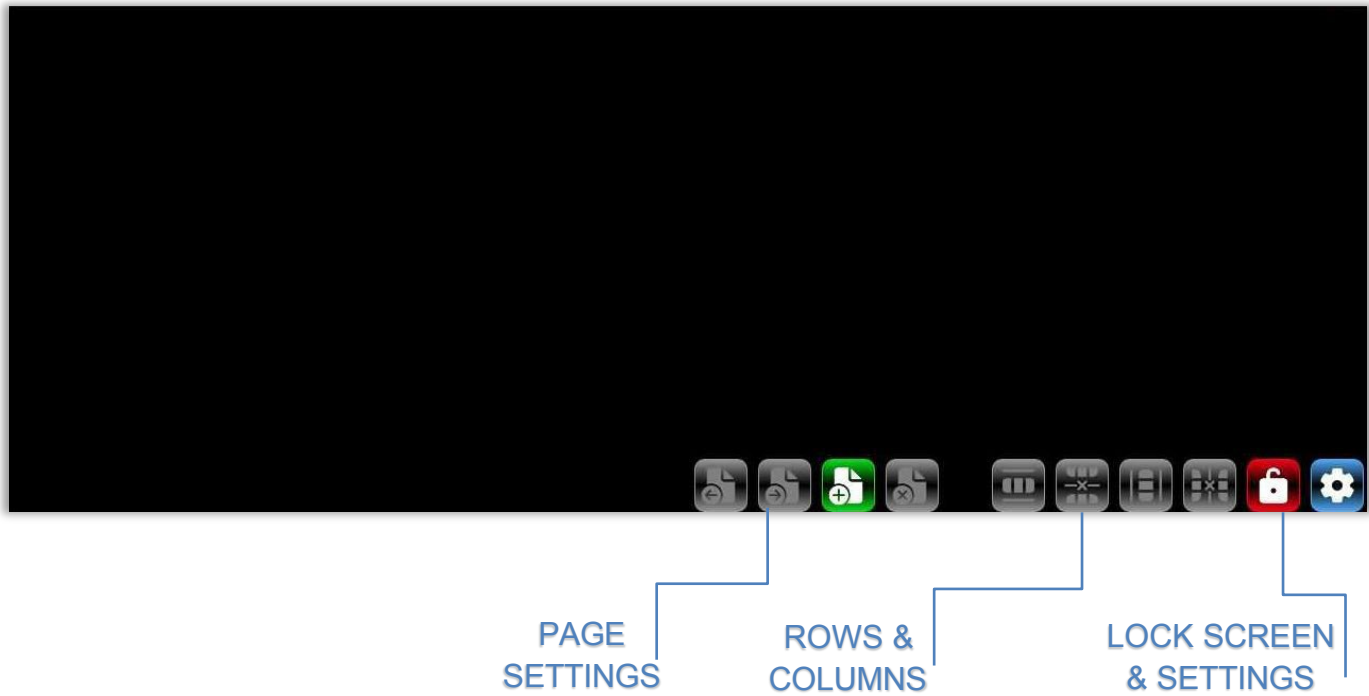
2. Unlocked screen / Setting options require pin access.

- Select **YES** or **NO** when the screen prompts for confirmation.

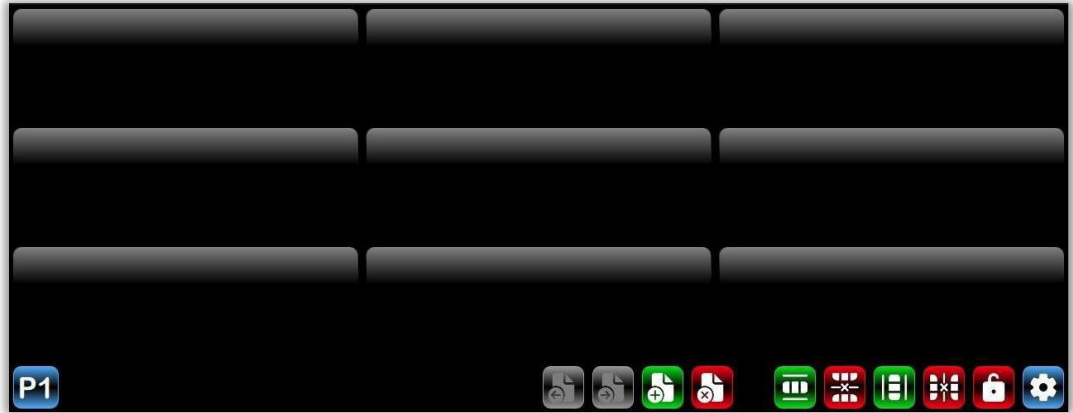

-  Select unlocked icon once you have customized timer to your needs refer to pgs.11-13.

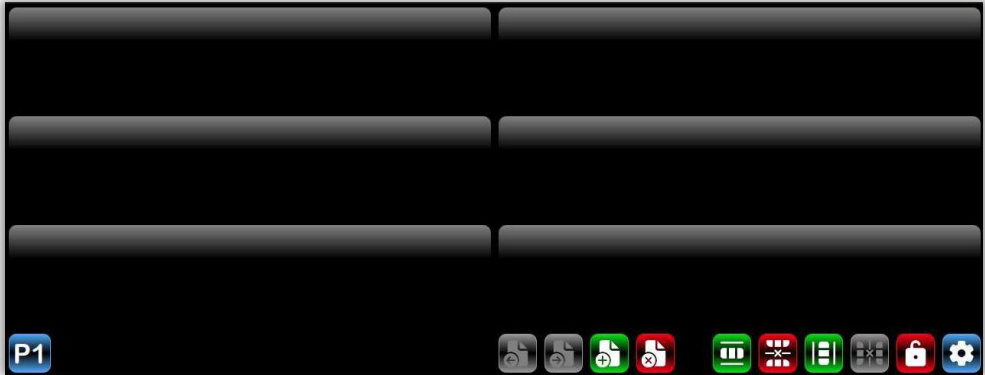

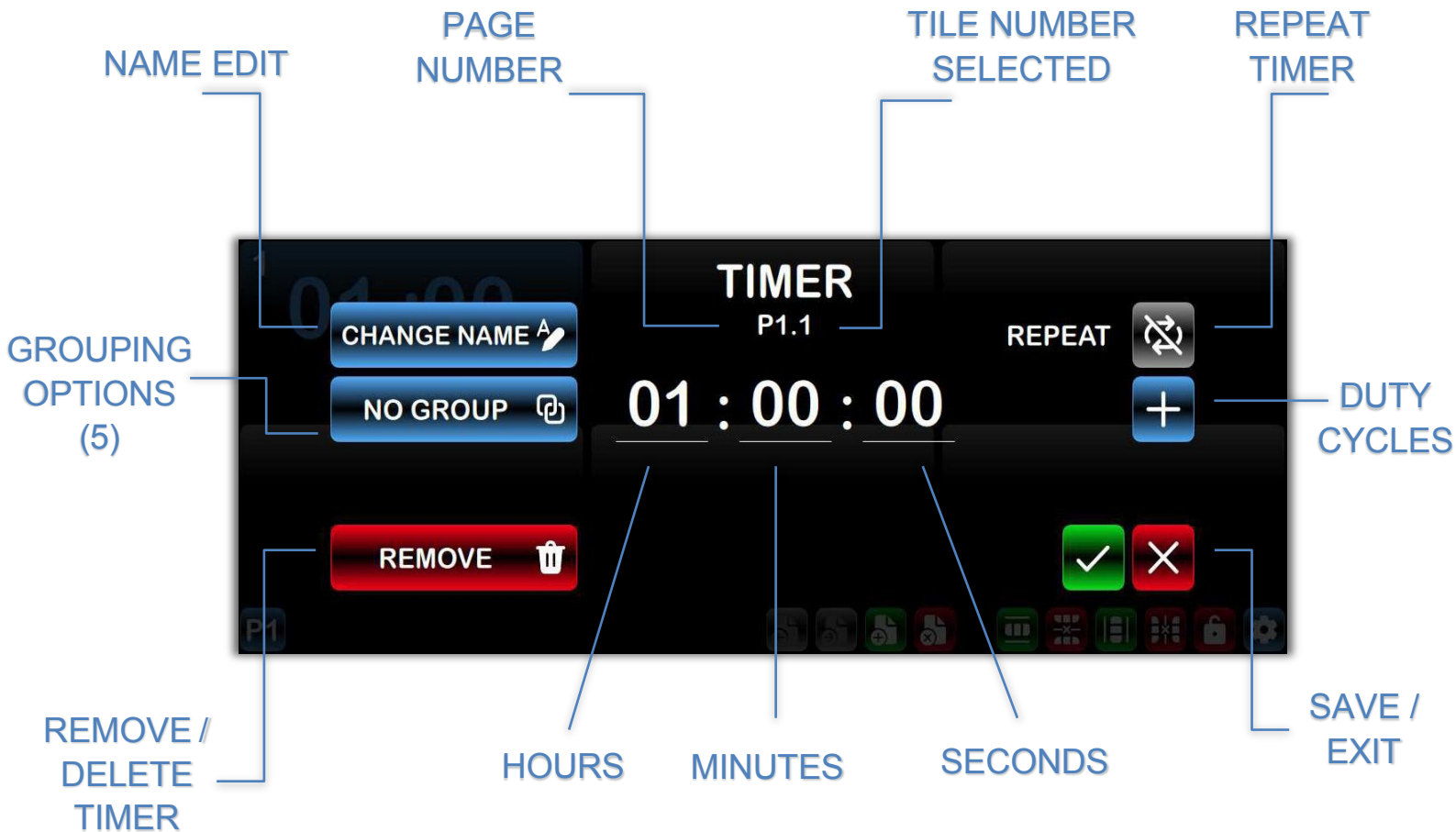
Programming Tile

1. Press  to begin customizing timer.

2. Select tile  again to start editing.

CUSTOMIZING TIMER TAB

Tile Name and Time

1. Edit **NAME** by selecting:

CHANGE NAME 

2. Select  to save **NAME**.



3. Edit **TIME** by pressing the number lines.

4. Select  to save **TIME**.



Repeat Function

1.  Enables **REPEAT TIMER** control:

Single press resets the timer / Single press stops timer



2.  Disables **REPEAT TIMER** control :

Press and hold again to reset timer / Press and hold to stop timer

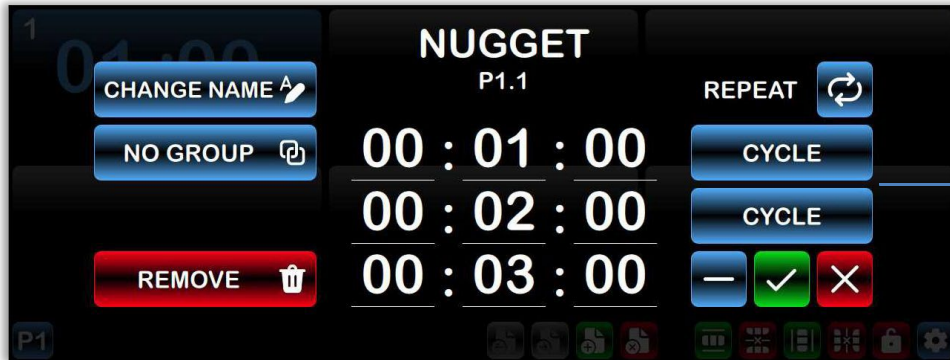


Duty Cycles

1. Create **Duty Cycles** (3x) by pressing:



2. Duty cycles suggestions are as followed :




3. Select  to save **DUTY CYCLE** chosen.

4. Display will read out **DUTY CYCLE** , press the tile to continue to next cycle or final timer .



Grouping

1. Select  to combine timers you will like to **GROUP** together.

 *Note: Add up to 5 groups*



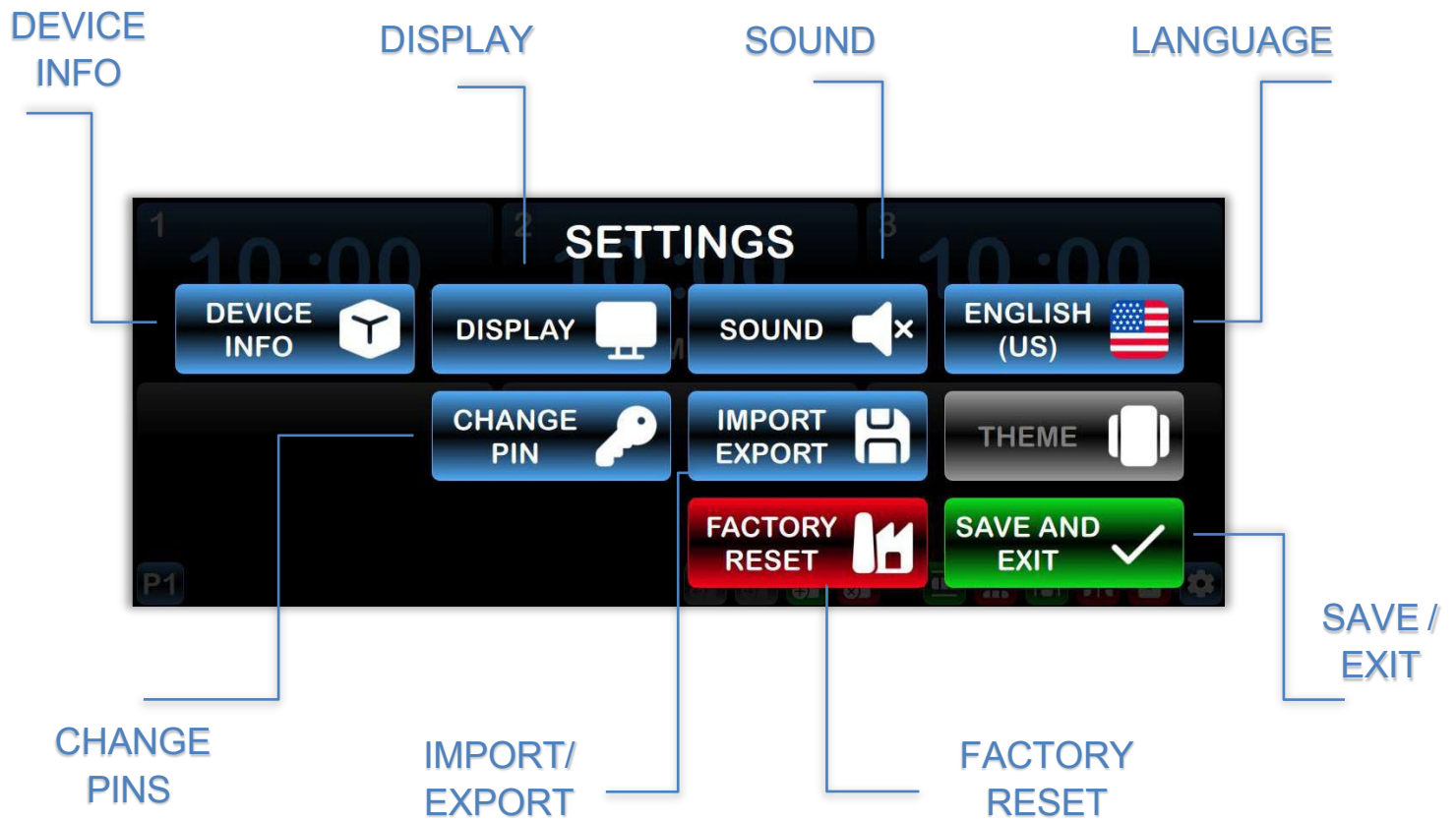
2. Lock in your final edited tile by pressing lock icon.



3. Press timer tile to **START**.



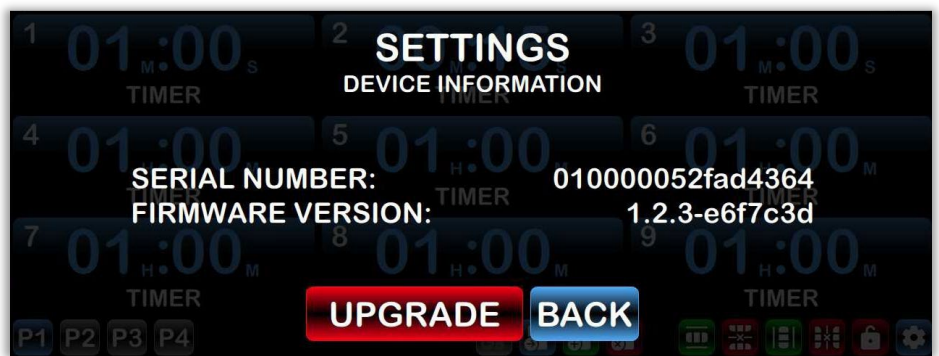

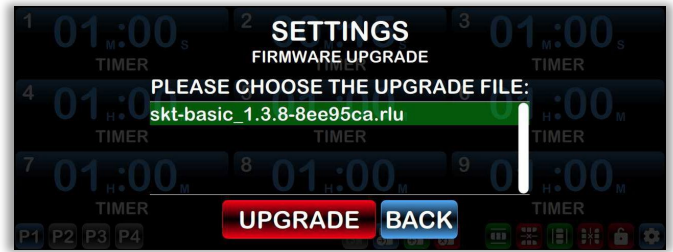
1. Select  for your timer's information **DEVICE FIRMWARE** and **SERIAL NUMBER**.

2. For an upgrade on **FIRMWARE** select **UPGRADE** and follow firmware upgrade directions on pg.15.

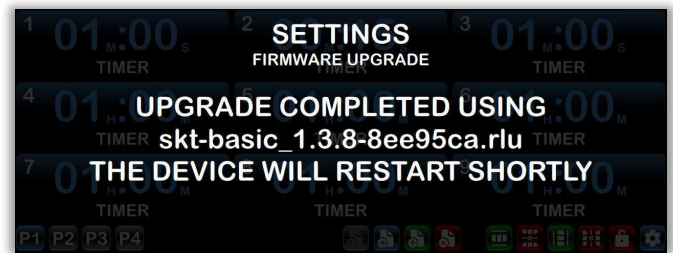


Firmware Upgrade

1. After selecting **UPGRADE** insert USB drive with new programming as shown.






2. Timers' system will automatically configure during the upgrade a notification will appear once the upgrade is complete.

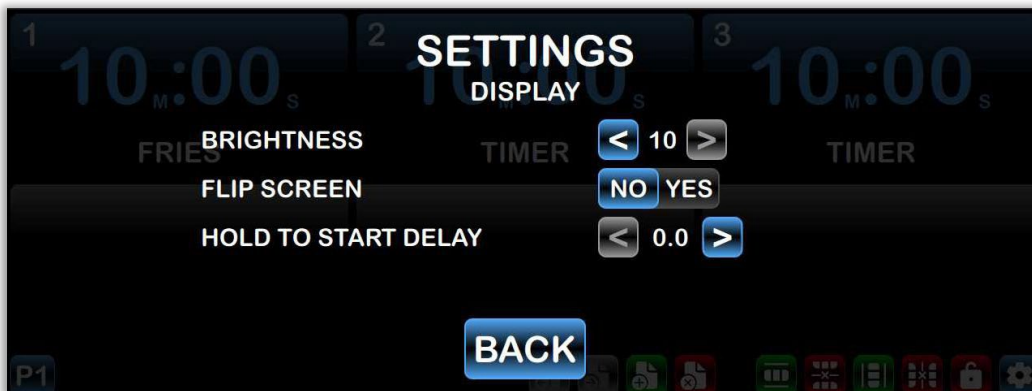


3. Timer will restart and will be ready to use.


Display Setting





1. Select  to open the display settings:

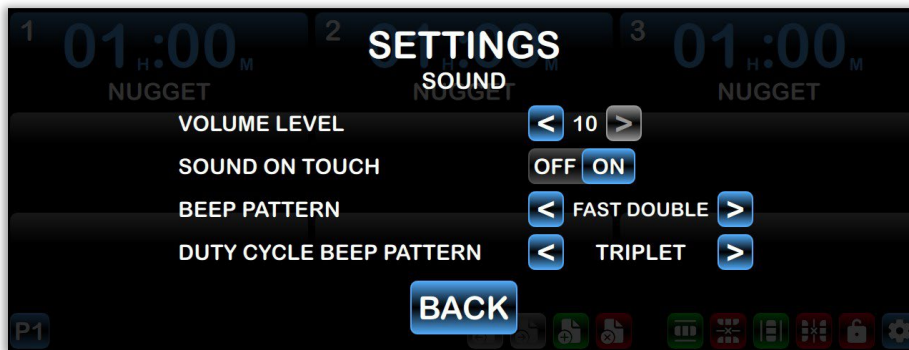
-  **BRIGHTNESS** – adjust how bright or dim the screen will be.
-  **FLIP SCREEN** – rotate or mirror the screen display.
-  **DELAY** – add or remove a delay (in seconds) before tile activation.



Sound Setting

1. Select  to open the sound settings:

-  **VOLUME LEVEL** – adjust how loud or soft the sound will be.
-  **SOUND ON TOUCH** – enable or disable sounds when you tap the screen.
-  **BEEP PATTERN** – choose the beep style (single, double, continuous).
-  **DUTY CYCLE BEEP PATTERN** – set how frequently the beep pattern repeats.



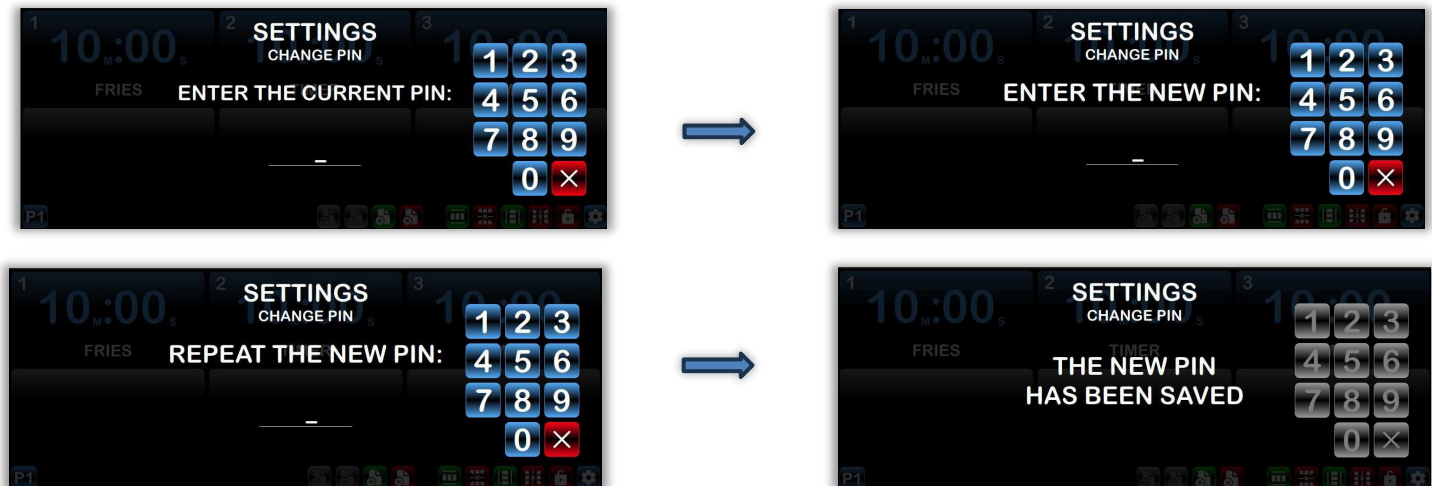
Change Pin

1. Select  to change your PIN.

2. Follow the instructions:

- Enter your **CURRENT PIN**
- Then enter your **NEW PIN** (twice to confirm)

3. Your new pin will be saved automatically.




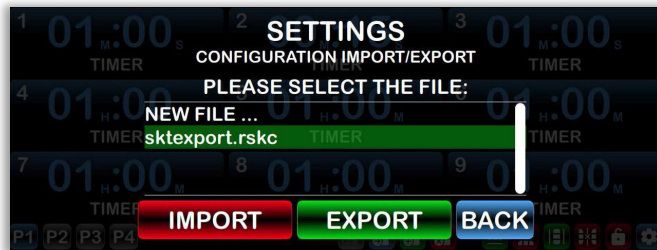
Language Setting

Import / Export

2. Select file to **IMPORT**.

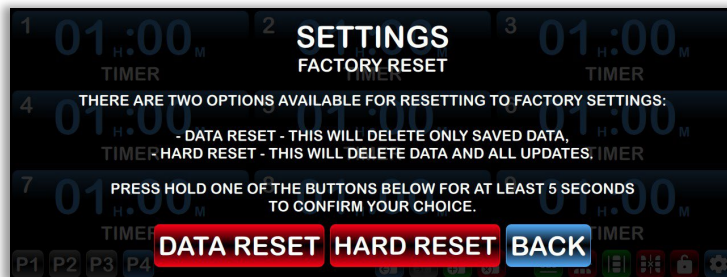

Factory Reset

1. Select  to access reset options choose from two options:
 - **DATA RESET** – deletes saved data only.
 - **HARD RESET** – deletes all data and all updates.
(*PIN CODE* will be required to confirm hard reset)
